Utah Governor Vetoes Bill Restricting Video Game Sales

Washington - Utah Gov. Jon M. Huntsman, Jr. has vetoed a bill passed by the legislature that would have punished retailers who sold M-rated games or R-rated DVDs to minors, under an amendment to the state's Truth in Advertising statute. "While protecting children from inappropriate materials is a laudable goal, the language of this bill is so broad that it likely will be struck down by the courts as an unconstitutional violation of the Dormant Commerce Clause and/or the First Amendment," Gov.

Huntsman wrote in a letter explaining his reasoning for the veto.
